

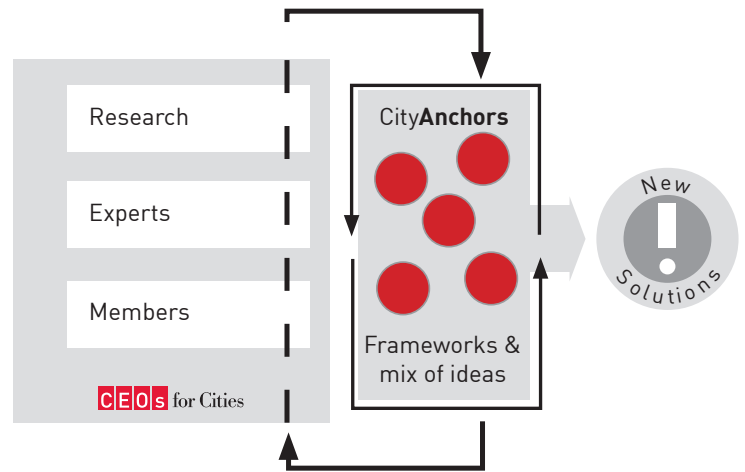

## Learning Network

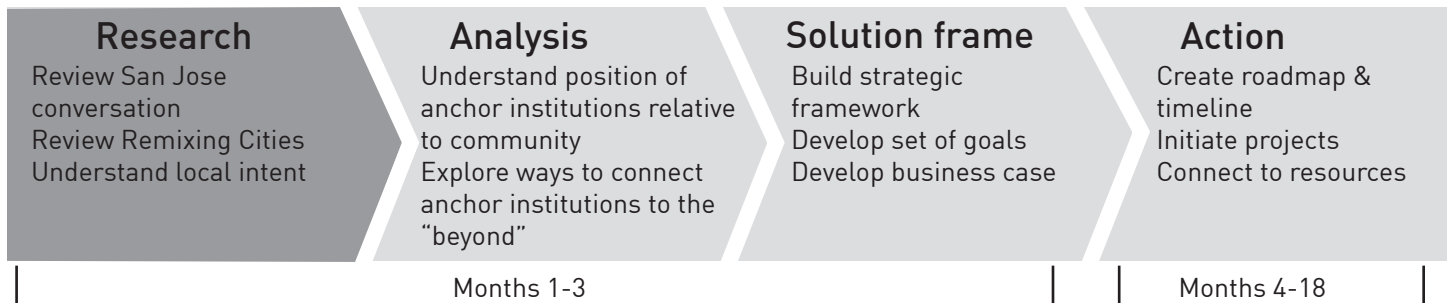
Working together with partner cities to gain new insights and invent new ways for:
